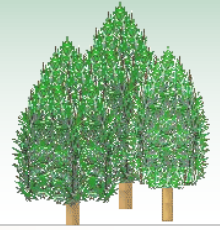

CITY OF DOUGLAS NEWS

The City of Douglas and Transwaste are proud to announce that the door-to-door recycling program will be going city-wide the week of October 4, 2010. Due to the success of the pilot door-to-door recycling program that began in January 2010, the City of Douglas and waste collection partners have determined it is feasible to bring curb-side recycling to all citizens.

On September 15, City of Douglas customers will receive an additional garbage cart with a blue lid to use for the collection of recyclables. This cart will be picked up on an alternating weekly basis with the regular green garbage cart. No sorting of recyclables is required. We prefer you leave recyclables unbagged or use a clear trash bag.

Recyclable items include cleaned: plastic milk jugs, plastic water and soda bottles, laundry soap jugs, aluminum cans, tin and steel cans, cardboard boxes, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, phone books, office paper, and food boxes. 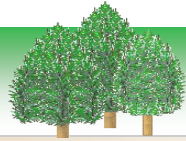
Tickets can be purchased for \$12 each, \$8 for children ages 12 and under, or receive 2 complimentary ones with a new Legion of Heritage membership.
