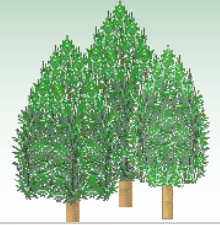

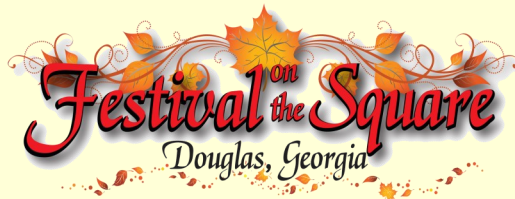
Natural Gas Week, October 3-9, 2010

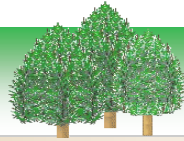

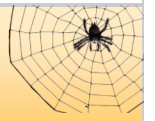
