GRANT DOLLARS AT WORK

The joint project with Coffee County at Huckaby Complex is almost complete! Completed so far: rehab of the (3) soft-ball fields, field lighting, installation of new bleachers with coverings, new dugouts with covering, replacement of all field fencing. Work continues on: repair/replace sidewalks, rehab/replace restrooms, and new equipment/rehab of concession stand. This joint project is funded in part by the Governor's Office of Planning and Budget/ Improving Neighborhood Outcomes Grant.



PARDON OUR PROGRESS

Work on the major water and sewer expansion project on Thompson Drive to the Barrington Agri-Business Park continues. This joint project with the Southern Georgia Regional Commission, Douglas-Coffee County Economic Development Authority, and the City of Douglas includes improvements in drinking water treatment, improvements of wastewater treatment, improvements in biosolids management, and improvements in the sewer system, and expansion of the natural gas system to support business growth. A total of (3) grants from the State of Georgia Water and Sewer Infrastructure Committee, Georgia Department of Economic Development OneGeorgia Equity Fund, and the U.S. Department of Commerce Economic Development Administration is funding with the project.

CITY OFFERS INCENTIVES FOR ENTERPRISE ZONES

In accordance with the State of Georgia's Enterprise Zone Employment Act of 1997, the City of Douglas has established five (5) Enterprise Zones in the city to encourage revitalization and investment in the areas. Property owners, who apply for the incentive program and successfully achieve and maintain the criteria set by the program, may qualify for abatement of municipal ad valorem (property) taxes for a ten (10) year period on business, commercial, and residential properties within the established Enterprise Zone geographic areas. The Electric Department of the City of Douglas received the System Improvement Award from the Electric Cities of Georgia (ECG) on June 10, 2025, at the ECG Engineering & Operations Conference 2025. The electric department received the award for its efficiency during and after Hurricane Helene. Hurricane Helene caused a complete power outage in Douglas, leaving no transmission or operational meters functioning in the city. The city's electrical system underwent reconstruction and was fully restored within 29 days, thanks to the department's linemen and numerous mutual aid crews who worked tirelessly to restore power for the residents.

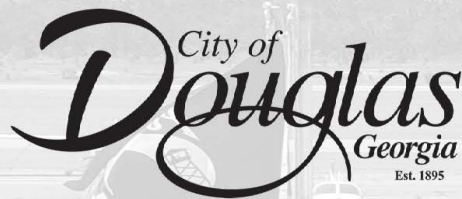

DON'T PUT YOUR PETS IN DANGER

102°! On an 85° day, it only takes ten minutes for the inside of your car to reach 102°, even when the windows have been left open an inch or two.

Within 30 minutes, the car's interior can reach 120°. When the temperature outside is a pleasant 70°, the inside of your car may be as much as *20 degrees hotter*.

Shade offers little protection on a hot day and moves with the sun. Pets most at risk for hyperthermia (overheating): young animals, elderly animals, overweight animals, those with short muzzles and those with thick or dark-colored coats.



A FORM OF CRUELTY— LITERALLY

Many states and local governments have laws that prohibit leaving an animal unattended in a motor vehicle under dangerous conditions, which include hot days. Under these laws, police, animal control agents, peace officers and others may be authorized to enter by whatever means necessary to remove the animal. You could have your car damaged, be charged with a crime, and fined or imprisoned. It's not worth it—don't leave your pet in the car!

HOT WEATHER TRAVELING TIPS

- Get a veterinary checkup before traveling and make sure you have the necessary vaccination certificates for the area you will be visiting, as well as flea and tick treatments.
- Carry a gallon thermos of cold water or bring along a two-liter plastic bottle of water you froze the night before.
- Exercise your pet during the coolest parts of the day (dawn and dusk), and never immediately following a meal.
- Hot asphalt and tar can burn sensitive paw pads. Walk your pet on grass or dirt when possible.
- Provide shade when your pet is outside on a hot day.

IF YOUR DOG IS OVERCOME BY THE HEAT

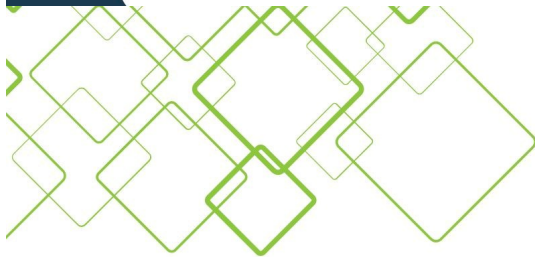
Bring down body temperature by soaking the animal in cool (not ice) water, but make sure water does not get into the mouth or nose of an unconscious animal. Seek immediate veterinary care.
