The event, hosted by The Hope Initiative, Hope for Coffee, and the City of Douglas, took place on Tuesday, July 22, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. in the park at 315 Alunza Street. This special occasion marked the launch of a new housing development designed to assist residents who suffered total home loss or were displaced due to the

devastating effects of Hurricane Helene. It also paid tribute to Mr. Lee Sims, who lost his life while helping with recovery efforts after the hurricane. Additionally, the development will provide workforce housing for those who have traveled to the community to aid in these efforts.

IS TRASH REALLY TRASH??

2nd & 3rd GRADE EDUCATION

This youth education program targets 2nd & 3rd grade students. It examines landfill waste reduction via the 3-Rs: Recycle, Reduce, Reuse. Students are taught about dump vs. landfills, products, product life spans, environmental stewardship and are equipped with tools to make smart consumer decisions before "throwing away" trash. Students will have a hands-on reuse activity by making a Water Bottle Outdoor Bird Feeder.

4th & 5th GRADE ELEMENTARY STUDENTS

This youth education program centers on 4th & 5th grade STEAM gardening, offering students a hands-on experience in various disciplines:

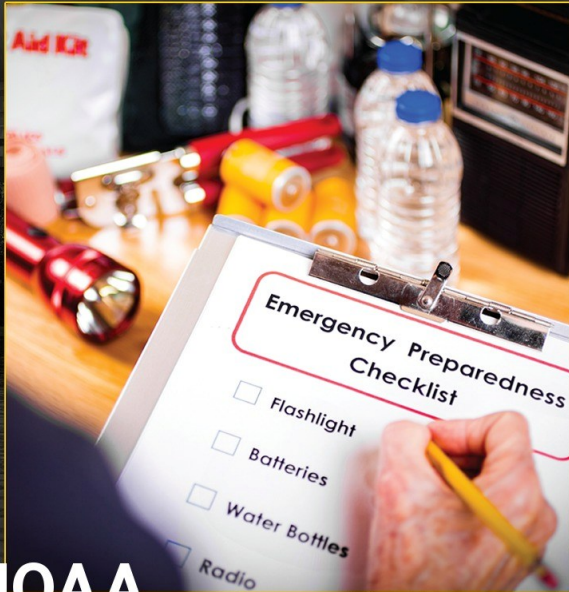
