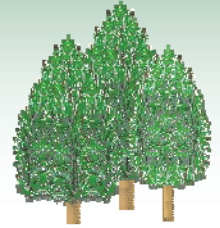

CITY INTRODUCES COMMERCIAL RECYCLING CARTS

The City of Douglas Recycling program is now offering their commercial customers recycling carts. Commercial customers can call the City of Douglas Customer Service Department at 389-3499 and request the carts to be delivered to their place of business. Customers can "mix & match" which will allow them to trade in a regular cart for a recycling cart. Commercial recycling carts will be emptied on a weekly basis. Items that can be recycled are plastic milk jugs, plastic soda and water bottles, laundry soap jugs, aluminum cans, tin & steel cans, cardboard boxes, newspaper, junk mail, magazines, catalogs, phone books, office paper, and food boxes. Recycling drop off centers are conveniently located at the Public Works Department behind City Hall, at Fire Station #1 on Gordon Street, and at the Southside Fire Station near the Airport. The Douglas Coffee County Parks & Recreation Department is continuing their partnership with the Alapaha Tutoring Center that provides healthy, summer meals for area youth. The program will begin June 1st and run through the end of July. Lunches will be available at four locations: Roundtree Center from 12:15pm-1:15pm, the Douglas Housing Authority Center on E. Bryan Street from 12:00pm-1:00pm, Young's Chapel Baptist Church from 12:30pm-1:30pm. True Praise Baptist Church will serve breakfast from 9:00am-10:00am and lunch from 12:00pm – 1:00pm. The program is FREE to all children under the age of 18.
