CITY OF DOUGLAS UTILITY CUSTOMER SERVICE DEPARTMENT CLOSED ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2012

On Monday, September 24, 2012, the Utility Customer Service Department at City Hall will be closed to the public due to a software conversion implementation. Customers will be able to enter City Hall; however, tellers will be unavailable to assist customers. To compensate for this inconvenience to customers within Ward 3 and 4, a due date adjustment will be made on September bills. Utility customers in these two wards should pay close attention to due dates on their utility bill for the month of September. Ward 3 utility bills will be due on September 25, 2012. Ward 3 cutoff date will be moved to September 26, 2012 for September only. Ward 4 utility bills will be due on the 26th of September. After September, Wards 3 and 4 will resume their normal due dates, respectively. Wards 1 and 2 dates will not be affected by this closure.

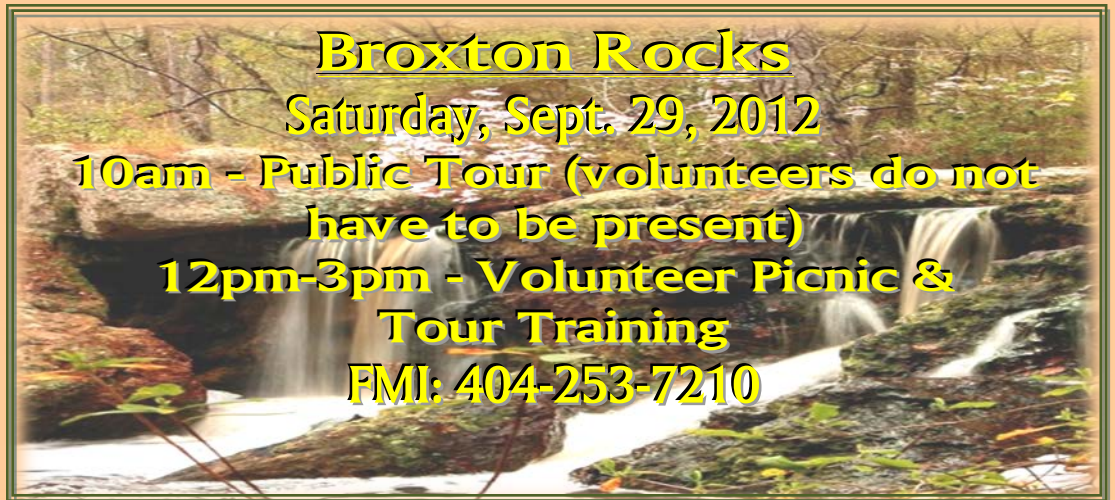
