City of Douglas Offices will be closed on Monday, November 11, 2013 in honor of Veterans Day.



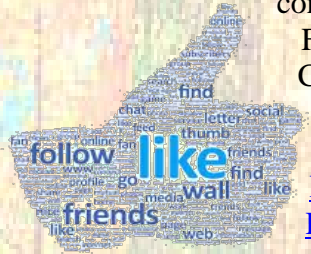
Congratulations to Utility Customer Rashonda Randall!

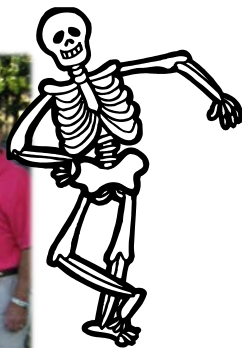
