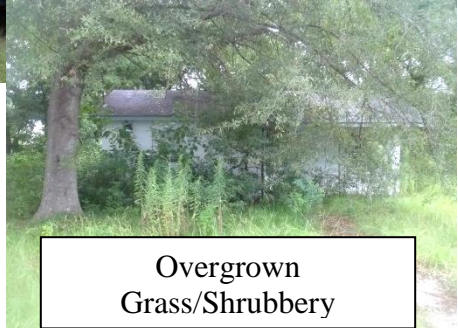
Progress continues on the [Compressed Natural Gas \(CNG\) Fueling Station](#), located on Pope Drive. Great news - construction is ahead of schedule!

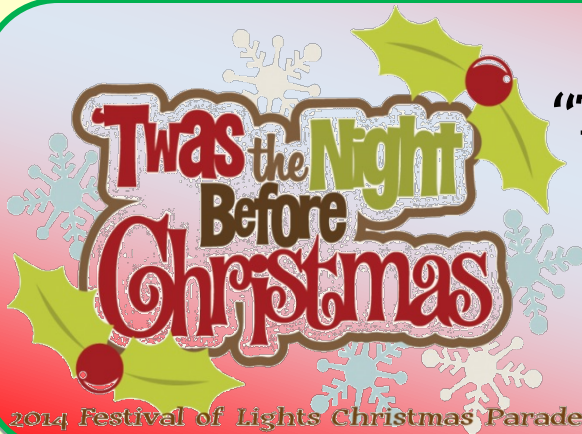
