LITTER REDUCTION Its up to all of us in our community to step it up and help reduce litter and waste in Douglas.

Join us for the **Great American Cleanup** and **Spring Junk Free Week** in April and for other scheduled litter reduction projects throughout the year such as **Plogging on the Greenway Trail**.

In January each year, volunteers and our community partners help citizens dispose of large, unwanted items during the **Clear Your Clutter Event**.

RECYCLING Help us collect used tires during **Tire Amnesty Week** that is held every year in April. Residents of Douglas are allowed to bring up to (4) tires per citizen at no charge to the City Pole Yard located at 1011 Shirley Avenue. Tires are recycled off-site.

In 2024, we collected over 100 bags of litter and 30 tires during the Great American Clean Up and Tire Amnesty Week.



BEAUTIFICATION Our **Community Park Clean Up Days** seek to improve the visual presentation of our community through programs that enhance our natural environment. These projects may range from painting a park shelter to planting trees or flowers.

EDUCATION We are implementing an education program with 3rd graders and including educational reading materials in our community's **Little Free Libraries**. We offer **Educational Programs** for students in grades Pre-K through 5th grade. Is Trash Really Trash, STEAM Gardening, and Reading With Lily the Litter Officer.
